When are Lifegroups?

Lifegroups typically meet every other week. Most meet on Sunday evenings, but some meet on weeknights. Lifegroups typically meet during the Fall (September through November) and the Spring (January through May).

What do Lifegroups study?

We give our Lifegroups the freedom to study whatever is best for their group at that time. Some Lifegroups discuss Sunday's sermon and are challenged to apply it to their lives in a deeper way. Others do a DVD based study and benefit from hearing some of today's best speakers. Still others may choose to read a book and discuss it.

What about childcare?

Each group is responsible for arranging child care for their group.

How do I get involved?

What if I don't like my Lifegroup?
